### 4<sup>TH</sup> TRANSNATIONAL PROJECT MEETING



The project partners met in Madrid, Spain on the 28<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> of May for the last transnational meeting of the European project ‘Digital Tools for Inclusion of Refugees, Asylum Seekers and Migrants’. The host partner of the project meeting was the Association of San Egidio in Madrid. During the meeting Professor Dr. Jesus Romero-Trillo presented the activities of the host organisation. The developed e-learning platform and its pilot testing was discussed together with the validation of the learning process

by a relevant certificate. It was explained how the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS) will be applied for the recognition of learning modules offered by the project’s e-learning platform. Lastly, the partners reviewed the project progress and agreed the deadlines for the activities in the last project phase.

### THE INTERNATIONAL MULTIPLIER FORUM



On the 30<sup>th</sup> of May the project’s international multiplier event was hosted by the Project Coordinator – DG of Social Services and Social Integration at the Community of Madrid. The auditorium was composed by civil society, public and private entities, including project beneficiaries as refugees, migrants and third country nationals from the 6 partner countries. The Project Coordinator Mrs. Mariasuncion Molina presented the aim and objectives of the project, and

also the activities and the results that were achieved during the project’s implementation. CARDET’s representative Ms. Ourania Miliou presented the elearning platform and its affordances and Dr. Stefanos Spaneas from the University of

Nicosia presented the process of accreditation in terms of ECTS and also the assessment tool which is available at the course platform and which will allow learners to receive a Certificate of Completion.

The representatives from the Spanish Ministries and the governmental officials from the Autonomous Community of Madrid talked about the national system for the Reception and Integration of refugees and asylum seekers, providing statistical data and practical information. Also, the work that has been done so far at the Refugees Reception Centres on the territory of Spain was explained and different associations presented examples of successful projects which have shown the involvement and contribution of the civil society in the integration of the migrants/refugees.



The celebrated project event was especially interesting to the international guests who had the opportunity to learn about the experience of Spain and exchange their best practices in the field with colleagues and experts from 6 EU Member States, for joint improvement of the integration process of refugees and asylum seekers at a European level.
